ULHS Landlord is the First to be Accredited by London Rental Standard

The Greater London Authority (GLA) has launched the London Rental Standard, in an attempt to raise professional standards and to increase confidence in the private rental sector in London.

The London Rental Standard is a voluntary accreditation scheme for both landlords and letting agents. It will bring together seven landlord accreditation schemes, which will operate under one single framework.

We were delighted to see that the first landlord to receive the London Rental Standard certificate of accreditation was one of our own landlords, Rob Hunter of Place Group UK. Rob has been registered with our service for over 8 years, during which time he has rented to many of our students.

On 28 May 2014, Rob had the honour of being presented his certificate by the Mayor of London, Boris Johnson. Boris Johnson visited one of Rob's properties in Haringey, North London, to meet him and his student tenants, to find out more about their experiences of renting in the private sector and discuss the benefits of accreditation.

At the ULHS, we have always supported landlord accreditation and so we are pleased to see the introduction of a new London wide accreditation scheme. We feel very proud of the service our landlords offer our students and we will continue to promote accreditation to our landlords, many of whom, we know, are already accredited. We hope that the introduction of the London Rental Standard will enable landlord and letting agents to understand their responsibilities and increase the level of service for private renters in London.
